The purpose of this program is to support nonprofit organizations that are aimed at improving the communities in which they operate. Specifically, projects should focus on education, domestic violence, health care, or Internet safety. Projects funded through this program should not duplicate or significantly overlap the work of federal, state, or local government agencies. An unspecified amount of funding is available to support awards through this program in FY 2010. Generally, awards will range from \$5,000 to \$10,000. Projects can last up to one year. Eligible applicants: academic institutions, local government, non-profits, and other school districts.

Doris Duke Charitable Foundation: Child Abuse Prevention

The purpose of this program is to promote the healthy development of children by protecting them from abuse and neglect. Programs should work to improve interactions between parents and their children, and increase parents' access to information and services that work to prevent child maltreatment before it occurs. Eligible applicants are nonprofit organizations based in the United States. Local organizations, individuals, and child advocacy centers are not eligible for funding. Mandatory letters of inquiry are accepted on a rolling basis.
