Parcel 2 to contain the remaining 54.50-acres, with a well for water to support an existing agricultural production use, natural onsite drainage for storm water, with no proposed wastewater facilities. Parcel 1 and 2 will both have direct access from North Cox Road. The site is currently under a Williamson Act contract
