SUBJECT: BENJAMIN HOLT DRIVE ROAD CLOSURE AND PARADE

In 2006, the Board of Supervisors adopted resolution R-06-697 authorizing a road closure for the Lincoln High School Music Boosters. The resolution requires the applicant to apply for an encroachment permit each year prior to the event. Accordingly, Lincoln High School Music Boosters has filed a permit application for the 2024 event. The proposed road closure is Benjamin Holt Drive, between Leesburg Place and Harrisburg Place. The parade and related road closure is scheduled for November 16 from 8:30am-2:30pm.

The Public Works Department has reviewed and approved the traffic control plan and has determined that full closure of the road is the safest solution to accommodate the event. Access will be maintained for local residents and emergency vehicles at all times. Traffic control includes signage in County right-of-way to alert the travelling public and control of several intersections by the California Highway Patrol.

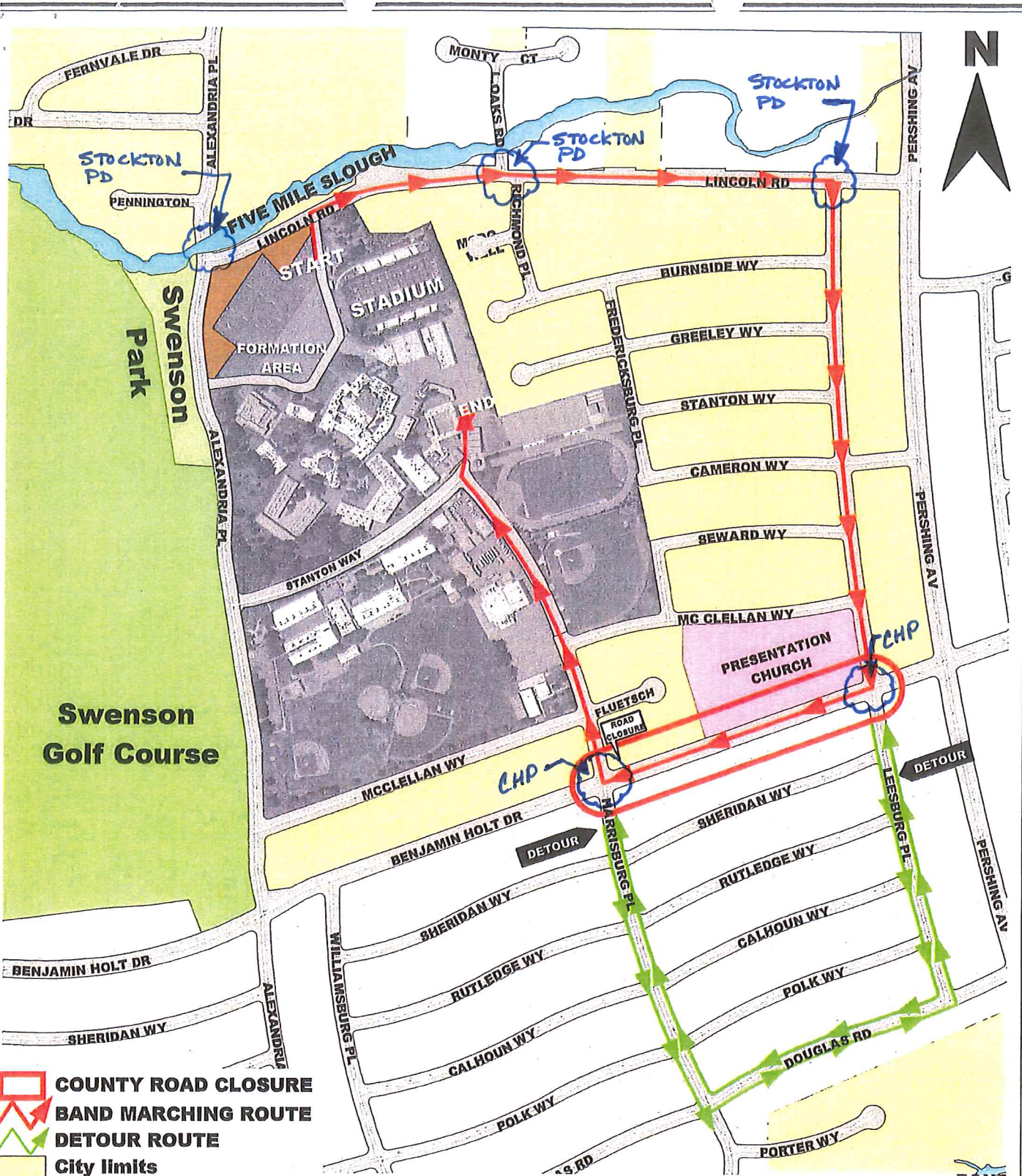
