**San Joaquin County Board Stands with Residents Amidst
Reports of Another PG&E Rate Increase Request**

Stockton – Board Chairman Robert Rickman issued the following statement on the reported request from PG&E for a second proposed rate increase:

“San Joaquin County residents are being hit from all sides by increasing costs and higher bills. At a time when grocery costs, housing costs and inflation are all impacting families’ monthly budgets, I am stunned by PG&E’s tone-deaf indifference to their customers. PG&E should not be able to continue to pass increasing costs on to its customers based on its lack of planning and lack of appropriate care for California infrastructure over the past decades.”
