San Joaquin County is \$18,902 for application and \$15,496 for monitoring. Over \$34,000 to start a program. Mountain Valley is \$2500. Stanislaus is \$2800. Sacramento is \$1881.	LEMSA rates and fees vary widely throughout the State as LEMSAs have different funding mechanisms and provide slightly different services for the fees paid. The SJCEMSA fees are approved by the County Board of Supervisors and are based on the amount of SJCEMSA staff time spent on the review and approval of proposed programs and the ongoing oversight of the programs to ensure ongoing compliance with applicable laws and regulation.
