If not, EMS crews may think this is an option and use it as normal operating procedure. If not clarified, could make scenes disorganized and resource requests duplicated.	The decision to have multi -point ordering or single point ordering will be decided by the Operations Section Chief or Incident Commander and will be incident specific.
EMS Policy No 7011, Multiple sections	Josh Capper Lathrop Manteca Fire	<p>There needs to be an indemnification to exculpate EMS personnel, the EMS system, and the County from liability due to the declaration of an MCI. Because an MCI causes a deviation from other established policies and protocols, there becomes conflicts in policies which expose us to potential litigation. A statement that says this policy supersedes all conflicting policies during or due to a declared disaster/MCI may help reduce that exposure.</p> <p>Pre- alert : "Any EMS personnel... shall notify the DCF... - does this mean that all responding units shall notify DCF and call a pre alert? Shouldn't we have a mechanism that once a pre alert is sent, then all responding units should be notified that a pre alert is in to reduce duplication of notifications?</p> <p>MCI Pre-alerts and Confirmation - is the intent for field operations to notify DCF directly on channel 6 or through their dispatch center?</p> <p>MCI Confirmation 2 or MGS B section - the incident name and the MGS name should match.</p> <p>Patient Distribution C - "minor" go to SJC hospitals closest 'from'? incident. Closest to incident? seems awkward.</p>	<p>SJCEMSA MCI policies are only in effect in the event of and during an MCI. To the extent the identified conditions exist, the MCI policies are required to be followed and inherently supersede other policies relating to the scope covered in the MCI policies during the MCI. No such statement is necessary for compliant actions taken by EMS personnel.</p> <p>Clarity will be provided in final policy.</p> <p>Pre-Alerts to be done on Med Channel 6 only.</p> <p>Following ICS, the incident name will be determined by the IC and relayed to MGS or OSC upon arrival.</p> <p>Clarity will be provided in the final version.</p>
