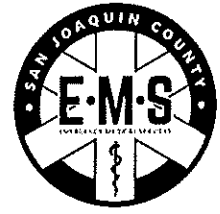

RE: Emergency Ambulance Services Rate Increase

Dear Mr. Caldera:

This letter is to inform you that San Joaquin County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SJCEMSA) is in receipt of your request to increase allowable emergency ALS ambulance rates dated, February 4, 2025. As specified in Section 10.2 Billing and Collections and Exhibit F of the Manteca District Ambulance Service (MDAS) agreement, rates shall increase by 6% to become effective on May 1, 2025, as shown below. MDAS' maximum allowable emergency ALS ambulance rates will increase as follows:

ALS Emergency Base Rate	\$3,729.77	\$3,953.56
BLS Emergency Base Rate	\$3,180.78	\$3,371.63
Night Charge	\$263.14	\$278.93
Oxygen	\$334.03	\$354.07
Mileage (per loaded mile)	\$79.14	\$83.89
EKG/Cardiac Monitor	\$105.51	\$111.84

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Further, as specified in Section 11.13 of the Agreement, MDAS' contract monitoring fee will be adjusted based on the same percentage of the increase authorized in the ambulance rate (6%). Effective December 1, 2025, the MDAS' contract monitoring fee will be \$29,808.90.
