
Temporary Bridge Closures to Marine Traffic through March 2025

San Joaquin County movable-span bridges will continue to be temporarily closed to marine traffic that requires a bridge opening for **Phase 1** construction work **through March 29, 2025.**

Vehicular traffic will be maintained during construction activities; however, drivers should expect one-lane closures and delays.







Temporary Bridge Closures

On October 1, 2024, the San Joaquin County Department of Public Works (SJC Public Works) began a project to rehabilitate the mechanical and electrical systems on four movable-span bridges in the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta. **The first phase will be extended through March 29, 2025.** Three bridges will remain closed (24 hours/7 days a week) to marine traffic that requires a bridge opening. Passage for small vessels that do not necessitate bridge openings will be maintained.

Vehicular traffic will continue to be accommodated on the bridges; however, one-lane closures should be expected during construction activities. Construction activities will generally occur from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday, with occasional night work. Advance construction message boards or signs will be in place to provide additional details.
