The breakdown across account cart sizes is an estimate calculated from actual accounts. Accounts for 30 and 90 gallon containers have been reduced to include an estimated count for 60 gallon containers. Future account numbers may vary.

Service Categories

Include an SB1383 compliant Blue and Green Container, which must also be collected weekly. One (1) Blue and one (1) Green container provided at no extra charge.

Disposal Site Gate Fees

When disposal site gate fees are adjusted by COUNTY, Lovelace Transfer Station fees for the residential refuse collection rates shall be adjusted by multiplying the amount of the annual per ton gate fee increase by 0.12 and rounded to the nearest one cent, to arrive at the amount of the residential rate increase allowed per month per equivalent 35-gallon basic container service, and proportionately for larger sized containers.

Discounted Rates

A Senior discount shall be equal to twenty percent (20%) of the rate equivalent to the first level of container service.

A Low Income discount shall be equal to thirty percent (30%) of the rate equivalent to the first level of container service.

The above discounted rates shall apply to the level of the container service provided.

Contamination Fee

A contamination fee of twenty-five percent (25%) of the container service rate may be applied to accounts with repeated instances of prohibited materials placed in incorrect containers for material processing.
