
What is a Special District?

- Form of local government created to provide a specific service within defined boundary
- Separate fund from rest of the County (legal requirement)
- Revenue from rates stays in the district, not spent for other purposes
- Generally self-supporting from customer charges –
 General fund unable to subsidize costs

San Joaquin County Public Works Department

- Administers over 100 special districts
- Services provided include water, sewer, storm drainage and street lighting
- Delivers water to over 5,600 properties

Elkhorn Estates Background




- Established in 1965
- 76 properties
- Water system includes 2 wells, over 1.2 miles of water main & 9 fire hydrants


Current Rates – Elkhorn Estates

- Annual charge per Single Family Equivalent (SFE)
- Single family residential parcel = 1 SFE
- Current annual rate: \$1,642 per SFE (\$136.83/month)
- Current metered rate: \$3.75 per 1,000 gallons
- Parcel specific charges are on the notices mailed to the property owners

District Expenses 5-Year Avg Annual O&M = \$107,124 (2018-2023)



District's Financial Status: Fund Balance, Revenues & Expenditures



Proposed Rates

- Rate increase covers operational expenses and contributions towards fund balance
- Ensures continued system maintenance, outdoor watering
- Positive fund balance after 5-year rate schedule

If Rates Are Not Approved

Without sufficient revenue, may need to impose extreme water conservation measures and/or implement other cost saving measures

- Reduce after-hours and weekend service calls
- Reduce regular system maintenance
- Postpone equipment replacement
- Require stage 3 conservation measures which means no outdoor watering (plants, trees, lawn, etc.)
