

November 5, 2024, GENERAL ELECTION LEGAL DEADLINE MEASURE CONSOLIDATION CALENDAR

County, Municipal, School, and Special District Measures

These dates **DO NOT** reflect San Joaquin County Registrar of Voters (ROV) **administrative** deadlines. This calendar is designed for submissions that did not make the recommended deadline but still meet the **legal** deadline requirement which is August 9, 2024 (E-88)

Measure Consolidation Deadline Information

The administrative deadlines provided by the ROV for measure consolidation have been implemented and are necessary to meet vendor and print deadlines for the County Voter Information Guide. Resolutions requesting election services and measure consolidation with this scheduled election should be filed in person with the Registrar of Voters (ROV) and should be filed no later than **5:00 p.m.** on **(E-134 DATE)**, to ensure seamless processing by the ROV.

Legal submissions under California Law are allowed until 88 days before any given election but are not ideal for meeting print vendor deadlines for San Joaquin County. It is encouraged to utilize the administrative deadlines set by the ROV however, this expedited calendar has been created for circumstances when the administrative deadline is impossible to meet.

*10 Day Public Examination Period

During the public examination period provided for in this calendar, a complete copy of the materials filed by a jurisdiction, as well as any arguments and rebuttals submitted thereafter will be available for public review in the Registrar of Voters' office located at 44 North San Joaquin Street, Suite 350, Stockton, CA 95202 during regular business hours. | (E-0) November 5 | <p>Election Day All polling places are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. for drop-off or in-person voting. Mailed ballots must be postmarked by this date. <i>Elections Code §§ 1000, 14212</i></p> |
| (E+28) December 3 | <p>Official End of Canvass of the Election The Registrar of Voters Office certifies election results; the governing bodies consolidated with this election receive a certified statement of the votes. <i>Elections Code §§ 15301, 15372, 15375</i></p> |
