

## **Important Note to Renters:**

If you rent your residence, the owner of the property may raise your rent by the amount of actual Mello-Roos tax levied. If you qualify for a senior reduction, the rental increase for the purpose of passing the tax through to you should reflect your senior citizen reduction.

## **General Notice to Seniors**

Who have not previously qualified for a Mello-Roos senior citizen reduction (excluding Brookside Estates Development)

You may qualify for a reduction of the Mello-Roos Special Tax that was approved by the voters in the Lincoln Unified School District on September 25, 1990, if you meet ALL of the following criteria:

- 1. You must be at least 62 years of age on or before July 1, 2025.
- 2. You must be the head of your household or the spouse of the head of your household.
- 3. No school age children may reside in or claim your dwelling.
- The address claimed must be your principal residence.

## If you meet all of the criteria listed above, you may apply for a senior citizen tax reduction by following the procedures listed below:

- 1. Between April 1 and May 15, 2025, come to the Lincoln Unified School District Education Center, located at 2010 West Swain Road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday-Friday only. If you have any questions please call 209-953-8700 or email ablanco@lusd.net or bthrasher@lusd.net.
- 2. Bring proof of your age such as a driver's license, birth certificate, passport, or other verifiable identification.
- 3. Bring assessor's parcel number for your property. The parcel number is located on your tax bill, or you may call the assessor's office for the information.
