



PROPERTY TAX CALENDAR

September Secured tax bills mailed November 1 First installment of secured taxes due December 10* Last day to pay first installment of secured taxes without penalty Lien date for property January 1 taxes Second installment of February 1 secured taxes due April 10* Last day to pay second installment of secured taxes without penalty June 30 End of fiscal year July 1 Beginning of fiscal year and unpaid secured taxes become defaulted taxes Unsecured tax bills mailed July and due August 31* Last day to pay unsecured

* If a delinquent date falls on a weekend or legal holiday, the delinquent date is the next business day.

ISSUES TO AVOID WHEN PAYING PROPERTY TAXES

Disregarding Supplemental Tax Bills

Supplemental tax bills are not mailed to lenders. Your lender will not pay the supplemental tax bill unless you have made specific arrangements.

◆ Check with your lender to determine if they will pay your supplemental taxes.

Unaware of Delinguent Dates

Some property taxes are not paid timely because new owners are unaware of the delinquent dates or did not receive a tax bill. Annual tax bills are mailed once a year and the due dates and delinquent dates are established by law. Penalties cannot be waived due to not receiving a tax bill.

Change of Mailing Address

Some property tax bills are not received because the property owner does not have the correct mailing address on file with the Assessor's Office.

◆ Changes of mailing address must be filed through the Assessor's Office. See their website for more details.

Online Bill Payment Through Bank

Banks will typically issue a paper check through the mail. Payments of this type can take many business days to arrive at our office and often do not include an official United State Postal Service (USPS) postmark. The payment must be received by our office before the delinquent date to avoid the late penalty.

◆ Pay online at sjcttc.org at no cost with an F-Check.

Late Payment Due to Postmark

The Treasurer-Tax Collector can only legally use official USPS postmarks to determine if a payment is timely. If a payment does not have an official USPS postmark it must be received by our office by the delinquent date to avoid the late penalty.

◆ Pay early online at sjcttc.org or request a USPS postmark on your envelope.

Unclaimed Funds

Visit sjcttc.org to view unclaimed funds with the Treasurer-Tax Collector and other agencies. We recommend that you follow the link to the State Controller's Office and search for unclaimed funds that may belong to you.
